The American Heritage Railroad was established in 2005. The Railroad is a Division of the American Farm Heritage Museum located in Greenville, IL on Museum Avenue just south of Interstate 70 exit 45. The Railroad and Museum have signed a sales agreement to acquire the following equipment:

- 15"-gauge Wagner-built Atlantic Steam Engine and tender, with 4 passenger cars, a caboose and a hopper car
- Miniature Train Company F-7 Outline Diesel G-16 Train Set including the engine, 2 passenger cars and a rear end observation car.
- 3,700 feet of 16 & 12 pound Railroad Track, with spikes, splice bars, etc.
- 7 Turnouts (switches)
- 2 Lighted Crossing Bucks (full size)
- Appox. 80-foot long Wooden Pavilion
- Misc. block signals, track gauge, rail bender, etc.

The Railroad has monthly meetings the second Tuesday of every month at 7:30p.m. at the Greenville Fire Station located on Harris Avenue. Everyone is welcome to attend.

Annual membership dues are \$15 which is membership into American Farm Heritage Museum. An additional \$15 for a 'ticket-to-ride' will help support the RR and give you unlimited rides for the calendar year. Please make your checks payable to: American Heritage Railroad.
